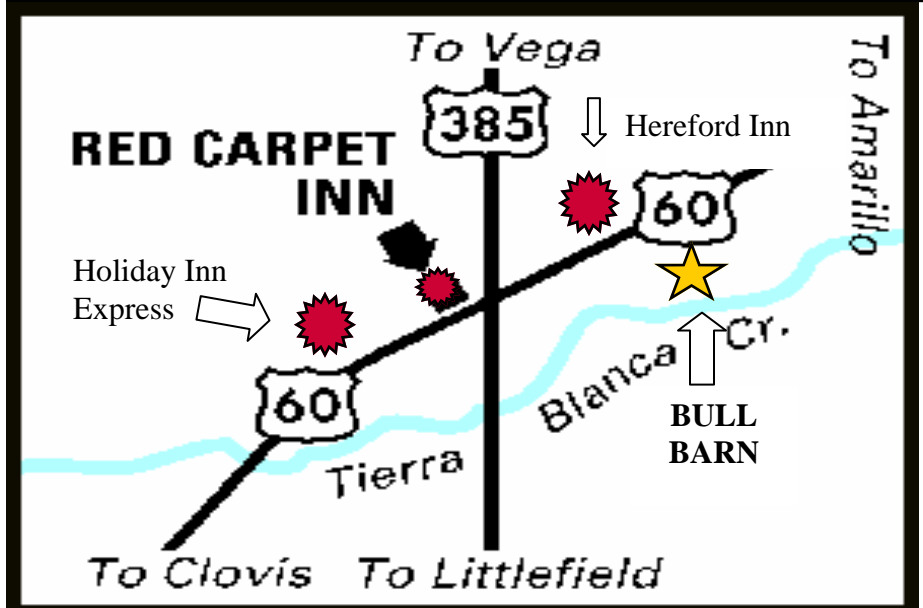

Show Rules

1. This is an ARBA Sanctioned Show. By the filing of your entry, you indicate your acceptance of all show rules and the rules of the ARBA which govern this show (section 45 – 46 exhibitors' rules of ARBA).
2. Entry fees: See individual rabbit entry for proper fees. All fees are per show class, per animal. Early Entry only, no day of show entries will be allowed. Please send entry forms to the appropriate secretary as listed in the show catalog by the deadline date. Entry payment must be received prior to judging. There will be a \$30.00 service charge for all returned checks. Entrants having had returned checks are asked to have cash, money order or certified funds, without exceptions.
3. All rabbits must have a permanent, legible ear marking in the left ear, or they will be disqualified from competition. Judges are instructed NOT to use a flashlight or any other artificial manner to read tattoos.
4. This is a carrier show. All carriers should have a leak proof bottom.
5. All animals showing signs of disease shall be removed from the showroom.
(Sec. 31, show sponsor rules of ARBA.)
6. NO RABBITS YOUNGER THAN SIX WEEKS OF AGE WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE PREMISIS.
Violators will forfeit show entry fee.
7. Shows **will not** have comment cards.
8. Substitutions will be allowed in the same breed, class, variety and sex only. Substitutions must be made at the secretary table prior to the show. Any other changes will be charged a late entry fee. **No changes or substitutions can be made at the show table.**
9. Exhibitors will be responsible for getting their animals to the judging tables as soon as the class is called. Rabbits will be called to the table 3 times only. We are hosting two separate shows, so stay alert! There will be no rejudging of the class.
10. Youth entries MUST be placed in the judging coop by a YOUTH. A YOUTH RABBIT PLACED ON THE TABLE BY AN ADULT WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THE SHOW.
11. All rights reserved to substitute judges in any event. The Show Superintendent reserves the right to make any changes deemed necessary. The judging order will be posted the day of the show and will not be known prior to the show.
12. No one will be allowed in the judging area except for the show officials and assistants. Absolutely NO interference with the judges or judging will be tolerated. The decision of the judges will be final.
13. The ARBA provides specific guidelines for protests. Any emergencies or concerns/complaints should be directed to the Show Officials. The Show Committee decisions will be final. The Top of Texas Rabbit Club reserves the right to remove any person or persons causing a problem and/or refusing entries to anyone found to be unethical or exhibiting unsportsman like behavior. The show officials reserve the right to refuse entry to exhibitors whose conduct, in the official's opinion, make it undesirable for the welfare of the show. If an exhibitor is barred, their stock will be barred from competition as well.
14. No awards will be mailed. Please pick them up at the end of the breed judging from the raffle table the day of the show.
15. Absolutely NO SMOKING and NO DOGS will be allowed in the show room, with the exception of working dogs.
16. Please keep control of all minors in your charge. If you or your minors are caught in off limits areas, your entries will be scratched and entry fees forfeited. Any damage will be at your expense and the police will be notified if necessary.
17. Top of Texas Rabbit Club or the owner agent, organization or the show facility or any related organization will not be held responsible for any type of loss or injury due to fire, theft, accident or providential destruction under any circumstances, to any person, animal, or personal property whether owned, borrowed or rented. Every precaution will be taken to prevent fire, theft, and accidents from happening.
18. Vendors are welcome. We do ask that you please donate to our raffle drawing in lieu of any fee.
